



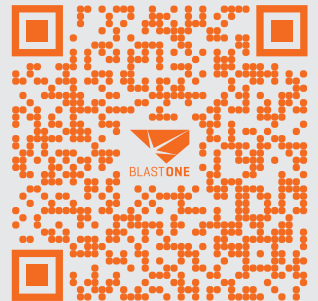
CRAFTWORKER SERIES | C6, C7 & C12

COURSE STRUCTURE

C6 – POWER-TOOL CLEANING

- ▲ Hand and Power tool surface preparation
- ▲ Brush and roller coating application, in accordance with good paint practice

Pre-requisites: Proof of a minimum of 150 documented hours experience in hand and power tool surface, preparation, brush and roller coating application.

C7 – ABRASIVE BLAST CLEANING

- ▲ Blast cleaning of steel and nonferrous surfaces
- ▲ Surface preparation, cleanliness, profile, dust and debris control, and abrasives.

Pre-requisites: none.

C12 – SPRAY PAINT APPLICATOR

- ▲ Skills assessment of sprayers.
- ▲ Training and certification of marine and industrial applicators
- ▲ Operation of airless/conventional spray equipment.

Pre-requisites: Proof of a minimum of 800 documented hours experience applying protective coatings with airless spray.
